



They should be plain black without any brand name anywhere on them. They should be clearly identifiable as shoes and not trainers, plimsolls, dolly shoes or boots. The guide is that when standing up, you should not be able to see socks. If in doubt, please ask us. High heels of any kind are not allowed. This list is not exhaustive but is to give guidance. Please speak to us if you want more help.

The shirt should be plain white and button all the way to the top. Blouse's or polo shirts are not acceptable.



Jumpers have always been, and will remain, an optional part of the school uniform. However, the only jumper students are allowed to wear will be the blue jumper with a Fitzharrys Badge.

Trousers should be a tailored plain black design and have no other details on them. This means no jeans or trousers with jeans features such as stitching or rivets, no labels (i.e. Miss Sixty), no extra shiny buttons on front or back, no leggings, no cargo pants, no drainpipes or tracksuit bottoms.



Jackets should be in a neutral colour and able to be worn over the top of the blazer. Any form of sports jumper, zip up or hooded top should not be worn to school. Denim, leather or other expensive jackets are also not permitted

Other notes

Ties

From September, we will only have clip on ties in stock. If your child loses their tie, damages their tie or decides to draw/graffiti on their tie, they will have to buy a new clip on one. Also, if we continually have to ask them to wear their tie in the correct manner therefore wasting learning time, we will speak to you and ask you to support us in ensuring they are dressed correctly. If they choose not to, we will ask you to buy a clip on tie instead.

Summer Uniform

In terms 5 and 6, students will be able to wear a summer uniform instead if they wish. This is the light blue Fitzharrys Polo Shirt. It is optional and students can continue to wear a shirt and tie if they wish. They can wear their blue Fitzharrys jumper with it if it is still a bit cold in terms 5 and 6.

PE kit

This remains the same as before and can be bought from the school shop.

Jewellery

The only jewellery that is allowed is one set of stud earrings and a watch. There must be no rings, bracelets of any kind or facial piercings, including nose studs.

Hair

This must be one natural colour and not extreme. Boys must be clean shaven.

Summer uniform

Students can wear a Fitzharrys Polo Shirt in the summer instead of their shirt and tie. The guidance for this is shown below. They can continue to wear their shirt and tie instead of the Fitzharrys Polo Shirt.

All other uniform rules regarding shoes, trousers, hair, make-up, jewellery and coats remain the same. Students must have the correct uniform all year round. Please consult the other guidance sheets on the website.



In summary, students can continue to wear their shirt and tie all year. They need to wear their blazers until we decide that the weather is too hot for them to continue wearing them. Students cannot choose to wear an outside jacket instead of their blazer in the summer. Only the blazer should be worn over the shirt and tie in the summer. James is illustrating this in the picture top left.

If students choose to wear a Fitzharrys Polo shirt, it should only be worn with a blue Fitzharrys v-necked jumper or an outside jacket of the sort shown in page 3 of the uniform guidance. This is in case it is cold or raining in the morning as students travel to school David is illustrating this in the picture on the left.

Hooded tops, zip up hooded tops or cardigans are never allowed as school uniform and should not be brought into school.

If students cannot wear their Fitzharrys Polo Shirt on a school day, they should wear their shirt and tie instead.
