Over 80% of student gained a place at their first-choice university. This September JMF6 students are heading a range of destinations, including Oxbridge, Russell group universities, employment, and apprenticeships. Included in those following the apprenticeship route is Ethan (pictured left), who achieved an A in Criminology, and Bs in Psychology and English Literature. He is starting his degree apprenticeship with Thames Valley Police in September.



Other individual successes include Grace, who achieved A\* grades in Geography and Economics, with an A in Maths. She is heading to the London School of Economics to study Politics and Economics. Jennifer achieved 2 A\* grades in Psychology and Criminology, alongside an A in Sociology. She is going to study Criminology at the University of Bath. Tom, pictured right, is going to study Business and Management at the University of Exeter, having achieved an A in Economics, alongside Bs in Criminology and Business.

These are just a few of the brilliant outcomes achieved by students across JMF6. They reflect the hard work and application shown across the last two years. We are also grateful for the expertise, guidance, and support of the staff across both schools, who have helped our students achieve so much.
