

2023-24: Term 2 Overview

Learning

ENGLISH:

Lord of the Flies with English Language Paper 1

Students will learn to explore theme and character and to comment on their development throughout the novel. Students will learn to analyse the language and structure of an extract, and to evaluate a critical opinion based on an extract. Students will learn to write creatively to a brief.

MATHS:

Individual class focus for this term:

- Miss Morgan & Mrs Payne's class: Pythagoras & Trigonometry, Angles, Algebra, and 3D shapes.
- Miss Keeble's class: Ratio & Proportion, and Pythagoras & Trigonometry.
- Mr Smytheman's class: Ratio & Proportion.
- Mr Whitley's class: Ratio & Proportion.
- Mr Poolman's class: Percentages, and Ratio & Proportion.

SCIENCE:

Triple Science

In **Biology**, students will be studying communicable diseases focusing on their transmission and symptoms. They will also look at how disease can be prevented through treatment such as vaccination.

In **Chemistry**, students will study molar calculations as well as completing key practicals such as titrations. They will also study electrolysis and how this can be used to extract aluminium from the ore bauxite.

In **Physics**, students will study a range of different electrical components in circuits and study the topic of UK mains electricity, its safe use, and the transmission of electricity from the power station to the consumer.

Combined Science

In Combined Science, students will study a **Physics** topic looking at UK mains electricity, its safe use, and the transmission of electricity from the power station to the consumer. They will also cover **Chemistry** topics looking at reactivity and making salts as well as chemical calculations and conservation of mass.

PSHE:

Celebrating Difference – Students will explore what equality means in the UK. The benefits of a multicultural society, the power dynamics in relationships, and the challenges of inequality will be covered. They will also gain insights into how health can impact life opportunities, and the importance of taking responsibility for one's wellbeing.
