## **Play for cash prizes in our 200 Club!**



Fancy the chance to win a cash prize every single month?

<u>The FSA 200 Club</u> is our monthly school lottery draw and is a fantastic and easy way to support the FSA. The 200 Club raises money for Fitzharrys School, particularly for larger projects which will benefit the greatest number of students.

Anyone over the age of 18 can buy shares. They cost just £5.00 per month, payable by Standing Order. The size of the prize money awarded depends on the number of shares sold, but if all 200 shares are sold, there will be 3 prizes each month of £250, £100, and £50. The total prize money equates to 50% of the total monthly 200 Club income, with the other 50% going to towards the FSA's fundraising goals. You are in with a great chance of winning; we have much better odds than the national lottery!
