

A large community such as Fitzharrys needs some clear guidelines of behaviour. Our guidelines are The Fitzharrys Code which is displayed in every classroom around the school. Any action of behaviour which could offend or hurt people or bring discredit to the school is unacceptable. IF IN DOUBT,,,,,, DON'T DO IT!

Firstly, you must not be on the school premises before 8.20am or after 3.25pm except when taking part in supervised school activities. This is for your own safety. The only entrance to the school is the school drive. Do not use the main doors; side entrances must be used when coming in or going out.

Only well-behaved and responsible pupils in Years 12-13 are allowed to leave the school at lunch time without permission. Pupils who wish to go home for lunch in years 7-11 may do so if their parents write a letter to their Head of Year explaining they will be going home by themselves and will be supervised whilst at home. A lunch pass will then be issued. This may be taken away if it is misused. Pupils in Years 7-11 cannot leave school at morning break.

Walking in school. When you are indoors keep to a single file and on the left. Leave classrooms tidy and do not leave until a passing class has cleared the corridor or stairway do not enter a room until the previous class has left.

Toilets should be used only in non-lesson times.

If you are sick, then the class teacher should complete an out of lesson form which then has to be signed by Head of Year. This note is then taken to Student Services. If you need to leave the premises during lesson times, then report to Student Services first to sign out.

You must wear the Fitzharrys uniform as on the uniform list. In particular, jewellery, obvious make-up, trainers and jeans are not to be worn in school. All items of clothing must have your name on them somewhere.

You are advised to take great care of money and valuables at all times. Do not leave them unattended. The following items must not be brought into school. They will be confiscated when found: personal stereos, radios or tape recorders; fireworks, cigarettes; lighters and matches, playing cards; knives; any sort of aerosol spray; anti-social joke devices such as water pistols and stink bombs; and chewing or bubble gum.

Smoking and gambling are strictly forbidden.

Food must be eaten in the Dining Hall, main hall or the upper school dining or the picnic area when weather permits and nowhere else inside. Put litter in bins provided, please. Anyone found breaking this particular rule may be obliged to pick up litter for half an hour.

If you come to school on your bike then leave it in the shed during the day. Bikes may not be ridden in school, except by Sixth Formers. You are strongly advised to padlock your bike, ensure it and stamp it with your postcode.

Motor bikes and cars belonging to pupils are not allowed on the site.

There is not public telephone on site, but you may use the office phone in an emergency.
